Rules and General Information

RULES - All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply.

Tournament Accreditation Number A03 / 0109

ELIGIBILITY - This tournament is open to all Junior bowlers affiliated with Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited.

NO REFUND AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE - Teams or Individuals who do not bowl in their allocated squads will not be entitled to claim a refund. Teams or Individuals who are unable to bowl in their event, can sell their spot to another competitor. Whilst the Tournament Committee will help where possible to reschedule entries, it is not the responsibility of the Tournament Committee to sell or recover money for unused entries.

DRESS CODE - Bowler's must wear neat acceptable attire. No jeans, collarless T shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing.

ENTERING AVERAGES - Each bowler must use the highest of their TBA accredited league averages over 18 games as of 31st December 2002.

GRADINGS - Based on averages submitted, entries will be Graded in accordance with the Tournament Gradings Table.

BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE - Any bowler without an average as described, may apply to TBA for classification prior to submitting an entry. If no such application is received, then an entering average of 189 for Boys and 179 for Girls will apply.

Note: Any bowler may enter in OPEN Grade.

AVERAGE REVIEW - The Tournament Director reserves the right to review the average and regrade any bowler prior to, or after the commencement of play. Using an incorrect average may result in disqualification.

REPLACEMENTS - Any change from the original Entry or line-up must be reported to the Tournament Office prior to the scheduled check-in

GAMES TO BE PLAYED - In each Grade a three (3) game series will be played in Teams, Doubles and Singles.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION - TEAMS - The same five (5) bowlers may bowl together any number of times and in any different combination.

DOUBLES - Bowlers may have unlimited entries with the same or different partner.

SINGLES - Bowlers may have unlimited entries in their grade or any grade above their own classification.

ALL EVENTS - An All Events Champion will be declared for each average classification for which paid entries are received. Scores from each bowler's BEST appearance in Teams, Doubles and Singles will count towards All Events total. Scores in the Mixed Teams and Mixed Doubles will count towards All Events.

Eligibility is subject to the payment of the \$5 fee. This Fee must be paid BEFORE bowling in their first Event.

PRIZE FUND - Trophies, medallions, shirts, awards and any other prizes will be purchased from the total prize fund received in the Championships. The prize fund distributed in cash or cheque, will be the balance remaining after purchases have been made and will be paid in the ratio of one (1) prize for every ten (10) entries, except in All Events where the ratio will be one (1) prize for every twenty (20) entries.

AGED CHAMPIONS EVENTS - A Boys and Girls Aged Champion division will be conducted simultaneously for Singles and All Events in the following Age groups. Under 10, Under 12, Under 14, Under 16 and Under 18. Entering Ages will be determined as the age of the bowler on the 27th June 2003. Only submit one (1) Entry per participant per event.

PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATES - Certificates will be available from the Tournament room. Persons wanting Participation Certificates should advise Tournament staff upon arrival. Please identify the years of participation for each player in the space provided on the Player Registration form.

NOTE - Any matters arising which are not covered by these Tournament Rules will be determined by the TBA Tournament Committee.

PLAYER CREDENTIALS - Players requesting copies of Credentials, must provide a "stamped" self-addressed envelope when submitting their Entries. Alternatively, credentials can be faxed if a facsimile number has been supplied. (Refer Registration Form)

CHILD PROTECTION POLICY - All Guardians, Coaches and Parents accompanying players and teams to the Championships, will be required to complete a "Good Character Declaration" which is available from TBA and State Association offices.

MOBILE PHONES - Competitors mobile phones must be turned off while competing in an event

SMOKING - Smoking is not permitted in AMF Forest Hill or AMF Boronia

AMF BORONIA BOWL - 125 Boronia Road, Boronia VIC 3155 4th, 5th and 6th July 2003

This event is a five (5) person team Intercentre challenge based on a handicap of 90% of 200. All Junior bowlers affiliated with TBA Centres are eligible to enter a team representing their centre. Team may be mixed and bowlers can be any junior bowler affiliated with Tenpin Bowling Australia who is not a member of a 2003 President's Junior Interstate Shield Team. All centres competing can enter a maximum of two (2) teams and additional squads will be scheduled should the need arise. Teams bowl eight (8) games qualifying over two (2) rounds. Top (8) eight teams based on total pinfall plus handicap, play (7) seven games in Round Robin match play and points awarded will be similar to that of the President's Junior Interstate Shield tournament. Match play will be scratch plus handicap. Pinfall from qualifying rounds will not be carried over into the final.

COST - \$350.00 per team

Qualifying Squads - Teams will be allocated into either "A" or "B" squad and should nominate their preferred qualifying squad on the entry form. Teams in round 1 who nominate "A" squad at 9.00am on Friday 4th July, will bowl "A" squad at 2.00pm in round 2 on Saturday 5th July. This will be the reverse for teams who nominate "B" squad in round one. Top 8 teams will be announced at the completion of Squad **Final -** The Final for the top eight teams will starts at 9.00am Sunday, 6th July 2003. Presentations and payout of prizes will be made at the completion of the final.

TENPIN BOWLING AUSTRALIA 2003 JUNIOR CLASSIC CUP

ELIGIBILITY - This is a scratch event which is open to all junior bowlers affiliated with Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited with an average no greater than Boys 180 and Girls 170 and who are bowling in the 2003 Australian Junior Championships. All bowlers (including the Defending Champions) must have completed an "All Events" entry in the 2003 Australian Junior National Championships

FORMAT - This is a scratch event with separate divisions for Boys and Girls and is conducted in two (2) separate stages.

Stage 1- Qualifying - Qualifying will be the highest three (3) game singles attempt bowled during the Championships until completion of the 6.00pm squad on Monday 7th July. Any Singles attempt used for Classic Cup qualifying will incur an additional qualifying fee of \$10.00 (Ten dollars) which must be paid prior to the squad in which the bowler is participating.

Stage 2 - Final - Top 28 qualifiers in Boys and Girls will bowl 8 games in blocks of 2 games changing lanes after each block. The final field will be made up of the Defending Champions (if eligible), and the balance based on the highest placed Boys and Girls qualifiers according to their qualifying scratch score. At the completion of 8 games, the boy and girl with the highest scratch pinfall will be declared the winners.

QUALIFYING - Qualifying will be the highest 3 game Singles attempt <u>plus entering handicap</u> bowled during the Championships until completion of the 1.00pm squad on Sunday 6th July. Any 3 game Singles attempt used for qualifying will incur an additional fee of \$10.00 (Ten Dollars) which must be paid prior to the squad in which the bowler is participating. Please note that confirmation of entering average and handicap may be requested.

FINAL - The top 28 qualifiers will go into the final according to their qualifying score. The final field will be made up

Defending Champions (if still eligible) who will be seeded No. 1. In the event of a tie for the final qualifying position a single game will be played to break the tie. Scratch pinfall plus entering handicap will decide. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken.

STAGE ONE – ELIMINATION FINAL - Finalist will play four (4) games in two (2) game blocks, with a lane change after two (2) games. Eligibility - This is a scratch event which is open to all junior bowlers affiliated with Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited. To be eligible to compete in the final, every bowler (including the Defending Champions) must have completed an "All Events" entry in the 2003 Australian Junior National Championships

Qualifying - Qualifying will be the highest three (3) game singles attempt bowled during the Australian Junior Championships until completion of the 11.00am squad on Saturday 12th July. Any Singles attempt used for qualifying will incur an additional qualifying fee of \$10.00 (Ten dollars) which must be paid prior to the squad in which the bowler is participating.

Seeded number one will be the Defending champion if still eligible and positions 2 to 10 will be made up of State, Territory and Zone Masters Champions. The next 22 bowlers will qualify according to their scratch pinfall. If any State, Territory or Zone Masters Champion does not exercise their right to participate in the Final, the number of qualifying positions available will be increased by one for each right not exercised.

Final - Stage 1 - All qualifying finalists will compete in 32 Masters Double Elimination format where the player can loose twice before being eliminated. Each match will be played over three (3) games with total scratch pinfall used to determine the winner. Pairings for matches in the Finals will be based on the qualifying position of the contestants and the State/Territory/Zone Champions as seeded by the Tournament Committee. In the case of ties for qualifying positions, the highest game played in the qualifying series will determine precedence.

Two (2) players will be assigned to each lane in the first three rounds of play. If a player fails to check-in for the Finals, the highest available non-qualifier will be invited to replace the absent player.

After the first match, no further replacements will be permitted. Non-appearance will result in forfeiture of the match with the player present bowling without opposition, and advancing to the next round. If the forfeiture occurs in the "Winners Bracket', the absent player will be relegated to the appropriate Match in the "Losers Bracket" for the next round. All players will be given practice on the pair of lanes assigned for their first match. Play will continue until there are 24 Boys and 24 Girls left in the competition. (ie; 8 boys and 8 girls have been eliminated)

Ties - In the event of any ties, a single game will be played to break the tie. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken.
