GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

RULES: All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply.

ELIGIBILITY: This ranked tournament is open to all TBA affiliated bowlers who are under 23 years of age on January 1st in the year of the competition.

DRESS CODE: Bowler's must wear neat acceptable attire. No jeans, collarless T shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing.

SMOKING and CONSUMPTION of ALCOHOL will be prohibited during a session of continuous games. Contravening this rule will evoke penalties defined in the TBA Code of Conduct.

INJURY/DAMAGES - Participants and visitors indemnify TBA from any injury, accident and damage to equipment whilst competing during this event or visiting the centre.

MOBILE PHONES Competitors mobile phones must be turned off while competing.

FORMAT: This is a scratch event with separate divisions for Male & Female and is conducted in two (2) separate stages.

STAGE 1—QUALIFYING: Bowlers seeking to qualify will bowl twelve (12) games on the first day.

STAGE 2—FINAL: 14 Males and 10 Females will compete in the final, based on the highest placed Male and Female qualifiers according to their qualifying scratch score. In the event of a tie for the final qualifying position, a single game will be played to break the tie. Scratch pin fall will decide. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken.

In the Male division, finalists will bowl 13 games of head to head and then a positional round, with 20 bonus points allocated for a win and 10 bonus points for a draw.

In the Female division, finalists will bowl 9 games of head to head and then a positional round, with 20 bonus points allocated for a win and 10 bonus points for a draw.

Qualifying pinfall will carry over into Stage 2.

Total pinfall plus bonus points will determine the overall winners. In the event of a tie, a single game will be played to break the tie. Scratch pinfall will decide. Bonus points will not count. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken.
