RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

RULES - All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply.

Accreditation Numbers Tournament A06/ 0017

State Teams Challenge: A06/0017

ELIGIBILITY - This tournament is open to all TBA Registered Players in good standing and who meet the requirements of a bowler with a disability under TBA rules on or prior to the first day of the Championship.

NO REFUND AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE - Teams or Individuals who do not bowl in their allocated squads will not be entitled to claim a refund. Teams or Individuals who are unable to bowl in their event, can sell their spot to another competitor. Whilst the Tournament Committee will help where possible to reschedule entries, it is not the responsibility of the Tournament committee to sell or recover money for unused entries.

DRESS CODE - Bowler's must wear neat acceptable attire. No jeans, T shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing.

ENTERING AVERAGES - Each bowler must use their highest current league average as at the 31st March, 2006 which has been established over a minimum of 18 games in a TBA Accredited League and including Touring Leagues.

GRADINGS - Based on averages submitted, entries will be Graded in accordance with the Australian Disability Championship Gradings Table.

BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE - Any bowler without an average as described, may apply to TBA for grading prior to submitting an entry. If no such application is received, then an entering average of 180 for Men and 170 for Women will apply.

Note: Any bowler may enter in OPEN Grade.

AVERAGE REVIEW - The Tournament Director reserves the right to review the average and regrade any bowler at any time. Participation using an incorrect average may result in disqualification.

REPLACEMENTS - Any change from the original Entry or line-up must be reported to the Tournament Room prior to the scheduled starting time.

GAMES TO BE PLAYED - In each Grade a three (3) game series will be played in Teams, Doubles and Singles.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION - TEAMS - In team events at least one partner must be changed. Bowlers may have a maximum of 4 entries.

DOUBLES - Bowlers may have 4 entries maximum which must be with a different partner.

SINGLES - Bowlers may have 4 entries maximum 2 in their own grade and 2 in any grade above their own.

ALL EVENTS - An All Events Champion will be declared for each grade in which paid entries are received. Scores from each bowler's first Teams, Doubles and Singles will count towards their All Events total. Eligibility is subject to the payment of the **\$5.00 ALL EVENTS FEE.** This Fee must be paid BEFORE bowling in their first Event.

AWARDS: Medals will be presented for 1^{st} , $2^{nd} \& 3^{rd}$ places in all grades for Singles, Doubles, Teams & All Events. Additionally, Trophies will be presented for the Highest Game overall (Male & Female), Highest Series overall (Male & Female) and Highest Pins over average overall (Male and Female) based on bowlers all events score. NOTE - Any matters arising which are not covered by these Tournament Rules will be determined by the TBA Tournament Committee.

SMOKING and CONSUMPTION of ALCOHOL will be prohibited during a session of continuous games. Contravening this rule will incur penalties defined in the TBA Code of Conduct.

INJURY/DAMAGES - Participants and visitors indemnify TBA from any injury, accident and damage to equipment whilst competing during the championship or visiting the centre.

MOBILE PHONES Competitors mobile phones must be turned off while competing in an event.

CODE OF CONDUCT: Tenpin Bowling Australia's Code of conduct will apply to this tournament
