Qualifying:

All bowlers will bowl 10 games qualifying in their allocated squad, changing lanes after every game.

Pinfall carries over to Day 2

Day 2: Pinfall carries over to each stage of Day 2

Top 32 will play 6 games with their carry over pinfall from Qualifying changing lanes after every game. The field will then cut to the Top 16 who will bowl a further 4 games with their carry over pinfall changing lanes after every game. The field will then cut to the Top 8 who will contest a 7 game match play with 20 bonus pins for a win & 10 for a draw.

Final standings will be determined on overall pinfall

Tournament Conditions:

1. TBA ranking points apply to this event. Lanes will be oiled in accordance to TBA specifications using the Kegel Oiling machine.
2. This event is open to all TBA Registered Players who compete in a TBA Registered Centre and who have not reached their 23rd birthday on the 1st January 2008.
3. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire.
4. Should a tie occur for 32nd place during qualifying or 16th & 8th place during the first & second round of day 2, the highest last game of qualifying will determine the advancer.
5. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke whilst actually competing in this event.
6. Bowlers not checked in by the advertised time for Day 2 will be disqualified and will have no claim on any prize money.
8. Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Director whose decision will be final.
9. All mobile phones are to be switched off/ or on silent whilst bowling.
10. All bowlers will be required to present their 2008 TBA Registered Player Card, or receipt of payment, at check-in. Only 2008 TBA Registered Player cardholders will be permitted to bowl. Cards will be available for purchase at check-in.
