Tournament Rules & Regulations

General Information This is a scratch tournament open to all Tenpin Bowling Australia (TBA) and WTBA registered players, and affiliates, who are under the age of 23 as at 1st January 2008. All TBA Rules and regulations shall apply at all times.

Bowlers are not permitted to smoke or use mobile phones while competing in the event.

CHECK-IN TIME All participants must check-in at the tournament counter at least thirty (30) minutes before the scheduled time. The Bowling Centre shall be the official time of the tournament.

PLAYING ATTIRE Bowlers are requested to be dressed for their events with a sense of decorum. Singlets, Jeans and track suits are not permitted.

BOWLING BALLS It is the bowler's responsibility that all weights and specifications of their bowling balls conform to WTBA regulations. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to examine the balls used by the participants. Use of an illegal ball is a ground for disqualification and forfeiture of game, prizes and standings, aside from penalties that may be imposed if such usage is proven to be deliberate.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES In the event of a tie in the last position in the qualifying round, a one game roll-off will serve as a tie breaker. In case of a further tie a 9th and 10th frame roll-off until the tie is broken.

OILING Uniform oiling shall be used throughout the entire tournament. The pattern will be posted on the TBA website seven (7) days prior to the event.

PROTESTS Must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Committee within 15 minutes of the completion of bowling in which the incident occurred or in the case of Matchplay, before the next round. In the case of the last match of the Grand Final such protest, if any, should be addressed to the Tournament Committee before prize presentation. No protest made after the prize presentation will be entertained.

SPECIAL NOTES

- The Tournament Directors reserve the right to accept or reject any entry they deem fit.
- Any matters arising not covered in these rules shall be dealt with by the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final
- No refund shall be made after entry has been registered and verified. Bowlers who do not show up for their scheduled squad time shall automatically forfeit all fees paid up.

Saturday September 6th - Day One

Qualifying—Stage One

All entrants will complete 10 games in one appearance in their nominated squad.

Lanes Washed & Oiled

Squad A—12.30pm Check in— 1.00pm bowl

Lanes Washed & Oiled

Squad B—4.30pm Check in— 5.00pm bowl

At the conclusion of qualifying, the top 20 bowlers will progress to the “Quarter Final”

Sunday September 7th — Day Two

Quarter Final — Stage Two

8.30am Check in— 9.00am bowl

Lanes Washed & Oiled

The top 20 bowlers bowl 6 games with pinfall from stage one to carryover.

At the conclusion of the 6 games, the top 10 bowlers will progress to the “Semi Final”

Semi Final — Stage Three

10.45am— Matchplay

The top 10 bowlers will bowl 9 games head to head matchplay. A 20 pin bonus for a win and 15 pin bonus for a draw will be awarded for each match. Total pinfall from stages 1 and 2 to carry over.

Stepladder Finals — Stage Four

1.15pm — Stepladder Final

The top 4 bowlers on total pinfall from stages 1, 2 and 3 will contest a one game stepladder final.

Should the top seed lose match 3, they have the right to a further one game re-match.
