FORMAT

Qualifying Stage 1

All Bowlers (Male and Female) will bowl 12 Games in two separate appearances in their allocated squad. Conditioning of the lanes will be carried out before A Squad and C Squad on day one, and before B Squad and D Squad on Day 2.

Oualifying Stage 2

Top 24 Men will bowl a further 6 games to decide the top 12 Men. Pinfall from Stage 1 will carry over.

Matchplay

Top 8 Women will bowl 7 games matchplay and the top 12 men will bowl 11 games matchplay. Pinfall from stage 1 for women and stage 2 for men will carry over. The winner of each match will be awarded 20 bonus pins. Bowlers will share the bonus pins in the event of a tie. At the completion of the matchplay round the top 3 male and female bowlers will advance to the Stepladder finals.

Stepladder

The top 3 bowlers (men & women) will compete in a 1 game stepladder match. The 1st match will be 3rd vs 2nd. The 2nd match will be the winner of match 1 vs 1st. The top qualifier after matchplay has the right to re-challenge. The winner of match 2 will be declared the 2008 Columbia South Pacific Champion.

TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

- This is a scratch event which is open to all bowlers who are TBA Registered Players, or are a sanctioned
 member of an Asian Bowling Federation (ABF) affiliated Congress. All games will be bowled in accordance
 with TBA rules and regulations.
- 2. No bowler is permitted to have more than one entry in this event.
- 3. Check-in and briefing is detailed in the tournament schedule on day one only.
- 4. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire. Jeans, track suits or shorts (men only) are not permitted.
- 5. Should a tie occur for 24th (men) or 8th (women) after qualifying stage 1 or a tie for 12th (men) after stage 2 or 3rd place (men & women) after matchplay, then a 1 (one) game playoff will be used to determine the tie. Should a tie still occur after the one game, then the 10th frame will be re-bowled until the tie is broken.
- Should the top qualifier after matchplay (men & women) be defeated in the final stepladder match, they will have the right to re-challenge. If any ties occur during the stepladder, the 10th frame will be re-bowled until the tie is broken.
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to check any bowler's equipment at any time. Any equipment found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize money.
- 8. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke whilst actually competing in this tournament.
- Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the AMF National Tournament Director, Brett Best, whose decision will be final.
- The right to represent Australia in the World Cup, airfares and accommodation will only be awarded to the highest placed Australian residents.
